**TELEPHONE SETS**

---

**1. GENERAL**

- 1.01 Telephones and associated inside wire and connectors are installed in the same premises as the Company provided network protection device.
- 1.02 They may be extended or installed in other locations such as in another building on the same property (CBB) or at a different property location such as an off-premises extension (OPX).(See Section 260)

**2. REGULATIONS**

- 2.01 The Company may determine the number of telephone sets permitted on the line by applying the Load Number (LN) methodology. The total LN for all telephone sets connected to a line should not exceed 100.
- 2.02 Most manufacturers provide the LN for their telephone sets. In its absence, the LN for a telephone set is deemed to be 20.
- 2.03 The Company does not guarantee the quality of service if more than (5) five standard telephone sets are present on a single line; the total LN not to exceed 100.
- 2.04 The Company does not undertake to provide satisfactory transmission on any call on which two or more telephones connected with the same service are used simultaneously.

**3. RATES**

- C 3.01 Telephone Sets are available for rent by existing set rental customers only. Existing rental of sets, at rates specified in Amtelecom Competitive Terminal Price List, will be Grandfathered. Telephone Sets can be purchased at rates specified in the Amtelecom Competitive Terminal Price List.
